

EBMUD Water Pipeline Replacement on Pleasant Hill Road

On August 23, 2021, East Bay Municipal Utility District (EBMUD) crews are scheduled to begin installing a new water pipeline on Pleasant Hill Road between Gregory Lane and Jemco Court (near Boyd Road). EBMUD crews will notify customers in advance of any service interruption due to the project. After the new pipeline is installed, crews will transfer water services, install fire hydrants, make final connections and flush lines for water quality. EBMUD expects to complete the pipeline installation by October 2021. As a reminder, the asphalt paving placed daily at the job site is temporary and is designed to provide a safe road surface during construction. Final paving occurs after all pipeline work is completed.

Work hours are expected to be 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday. Crews will provide daily traffic controls. Through-traffic along Pleasant Hill Road will be maintained for residents and emergency vehicles. Intersecting side streets and driveways may be temporarily impacted, and residents should anticipate some minor delays when entering and leaving the area. Residents should also expect the temporary placement of materials and equipment in the work area. Motorists are reminded to always use caution, observe all posted traffic signage, and follow flaggers instructions when driving through the work area.
