

EBMUD Water Pipeline Replacement Project on Grayson Road

In the coming week, East Bay Municipal Utility District (EBMUD) crews plan to begin work on a water pipeline replacement on Grayson Road. The project involves replacing approximately 3,100 feet of 6" and 8" diameter water main on Grayson Road between Reliez Valley Road and Grayson Lane. The daily work hours are expected to be 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday.

Crews will give advance notification of any planned service interruptions to impacted residents. There will be daily traffic controls through and around the work area, and motorists are asked to follow all posted signage and follow flaggers instructions.

Residents may experience some temporary traffic delays, especially when entering or leaving the work area. The completed water pipeline, expected to be complete in January 2022, will improve water service and reliability to the neighborhood.
